

This Guide is for groups of 15 or more, but applies to all trips with the exception of #4.

How it Works: After booking and Payment.

1: Trip times shown are arrival times. Vans depart for the river 10 minutes from the top of the hour. 12:30pm arrival, 12:50 departure.

2: Have everyone change clothes if needed. It is best to show up dressed for the river.

3: Have a group leader come in with signed waivers to check-in. No need for the entire group to enter the shop. We have plenty of extra forms if needed.

4: Ask your group to assemble in front of the shop ready to go. You will be asked to divide into groups of 10 -14. You may want to assign groups before arrival. You know how kids are!!

5: Load up for departure. The ride in the van is 15 minutes to our put-in. Along the way your driver/Tube specialist will show you where the take-out is and all the cool spots to hang out and swim and other do's and don'ts.

6: We have arrived! First thing everyone out of the van and assemble in the grass not in the road. Guides will start handing out tubes, everyone grabs a tube.

7: Once on the river, relax, float and have a great time. Normal float time is roughly 2 hrs, however there is no rush. If the float takes 3 hours, so be it.

Take-Out/Pick Up:

Each person should hang on to his or her tube. Rinse the tube off and remove any collected rocks(it happens a lot) before carrying tubes to the van. Please do not drag tubes through the sand or the road.

Ride back to our outpost is 5 minutes.

Unload, change clothes and hang out if you like. We have plenty of room for frisbees, kick balls and just running around.

GEAR:

Sun block, preferably waterproof.

Shoes that stay on your feet.

Flip Flops = NO. We throw away a lot of single shoes each season.

Snacks if you wish or lunch afterwards. We have picnic tables if you bring your lunch and would like to dine at our property. There is also a small diner across the street for burgers and hot dogs if you like.

Change of clothes, towel.

Water (regardless of what else you bring, have water with you to stay hydrated)

Cell phone if you must with dry bag/box. We do sell waterproof phone cases if you want to purchase one of ours.

This does not prevent phones from being lost.
